14 MAY 2023 :: DAY 01 : X ARRIVE AT SRINAGAR AIRPORT. DRIVE - 🚔 - HOTEL

17 MAY 2023 :: DAY 04 : SRINAGAR - 🚝 - KARGIL (201 KM – APPROX 06 HRS DRIVE)

Morning our driver will pick up you from Srinagar hotel and transferred from to Kargil. The most difficult section of this highway i.e. Zoji La (Zojila Pass) was a few hours away and you were eagerly waiting for an encounter with it. Conquering Zoji La (Zoji Pass or Zojila Pass) – "La" means pass. After crossing Zoji La the roads were very decent and at places went through snow walls on both sides. You had only covered 3 KMs after Zoji La where we saw a beautiful glacier and fresh water stream coming out of it that compelled you to take a halt. Drive towards Dras The Dras valley starts from the base of the Zojila pass, the Himalayan gateway to Ladakh. On the way you will explore Kargil War Memorial built alongside the highway in remembrance of sacrifices done by our armed forces during 1999 Kargil war.



The memorial is built on the foothills of Tololong Hill and has a huge epitaph with names of all the officers and soldiers who gave supreme sacrifice in the war. On arrival in karil overnight stay in Kargil.

MEAL - BREAKFAST & DINNER

<u>18 MAY 2023 :: DAY 05 : KARGIL - 🚝 - LEH</u> (220 KM – APPROX 05 HRS DRIVE)

Post breakfast embark on a drive to Leh which is 230 kilometers from Kargil town. En-route visit Mulbek, Giant Living Buddha Sculpture on Rock Mountain, Lamayuru, one of the oldest Monastery of Ladakh and enjoy the view of Moon Landscape, Magnetic hills, Sangum where Indus & Zanskar river meets, Pathar Sahab Gurudwara. By the evening, arrive Leh and check in at the hotel in Leh.



MEAL - BREAKFAST & DINNER

19 MAY 2023 :: DAY 06 : LEH - KHARDUNG LA - 🚝 - DISKIT - 🧮 - HUNDER (NUBRA VALLEY)



After breakfast, your driver takes you to the Nubra valley passing through the Khardung La pass, the world's highest motorable road at an elevation of 5,602 metres. From the top, there is an amazing view of the K2 mountain range (the Karakoram). Drive down to the Nubra Valley which means "valley of flowers" in Ladakhi language. The valley lies at an average altitude of 3,100 metres and it is crisscrossed by the Nubra and Shayok rivers. Visit the Diskit monastery, the largest and oldest gompa in the Nubra valley. Perched atop a rocky hillock, the monastery was established by Changzem Tserab Zangpo in the 15th century. At the top of a nearby hill, there is a colossal 32-metre-high statue of Maitreya Buddha, one of the landmarks of the valley. From Diskit, follow the Shayok river for 10 km to reach Hunder village where you can spend the night.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

20 MAY 2023 :: DAY 07 : HUNDER (NUBRA VALLEY) - 🚝 - SUMUR - SHAYOK - TANGTSE - PANGONG LAKE



This morning, experience a camel ride across the Hunder sand dunes. The double-humped Bactrian camels were brought to Ladakh when Hunder was a stopping point for caravans travelling on the old Silk Road. Next, visit the Samstanling monastery in the charming village of Sumur. From here, drive along the Shayok river towards Pangong, an adventurous road trip through beautiful mountain scenery. After passing through Tangtse village, there is another 35 km to reach Pangong lake commonly known as Pangong Tso ("Tso" means "lake" in Ladakhi language). The lake lies at an elevation of 4,250m, it is 140 km in length but only 30% of it is in India. Despite its brackish water, the lake freezes completely in winter when temperatures fall well below -20°C. Pangong lake was made famous when it featured in the Bollywood movie "3 Idiots" released in 2009. Overnight stay in Pangong Lake.

21 MAY 2023 :: DAY 08 : PANGONG LAKE - 🚝 - CHANG LA PASS – LEH



Take a stroll along the shore of Pangong lake and watch the sunrise over the glistening blue waters. The lake is a wonderful place for wildlife enthusiasts as it serves as a breeding site for various migratory birds. Next, go back towards Leh. After driving over the Chang La pass located at an altitude of 5,360m, you reach Chemrey village where you can visit the beautiful Chemrey monastery rising above the barley fields. The monastery was built in the 17th century in memory of the king Sengge Namgyal. In the Indus valley, head to Leh. On arrival you can visit local market for shopping after that come back to hotel overnight stay in Leh.

22 MAY 2023 :: DAY 09 : LEH HOTEL - 🚝 - LEH AIRPORT - 🧮 CATCH FLIGHT FOR HOME

- Ladakh being a cold desert doesn't have star category hotels. Hotels in Leh are very basic which cannot be compared with the hotels of other developed destinations
- Most of the hotels in the region do not have elevators and guests would have to use stairs to reach their rooms
- > Check in Check out 12.00 noon at all hotels.
- Fixed menu/buffet meals will be provided at the hotels
- > Only vegetarian meals will be provided at Nubra and Pangong
- > Hotels may not be able to give you the same rooms on your 2nd and 3rd visit
- > Hotels/camps provide hot water from 6-8 AM and 6-8 PM only
- One room can accommodate a maximum of 3 passengers (1 Dbl Room + 1 extra bed)
- Per person rates (Rs) are usually applicable on 2 persons staying together sharing the same room, unless specified otherwise
- > The hotels and services as mentioned in the itinerary are subject to confirmation.
- > Leh and remote areas have regular power outages
- Since vehicles in Leh are purely owned and managed by the Transport Union, your vehicle and drivers may change for every transfer and sightseeing
- Your drivers come from remote places and are not as educated as you. You are therefore requested to be soft spoken and gentle with them
- > Vehicle provided will be as per the itinerary and not at personal disposal

- During the period of May to August, there is lot of rush/traffic jams in the sector. Please be patient at the time of check-in/sightseeing
