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




TOUR ~ ITINERARY

DAY - 01 : CATCH FLIGHT FOR DHARMSHALA ARRIVAL IN DHARMSHALA AIRPORT - = TRANSFER DALHAUSIE (125 KM – 04 HRS DRIVE APPROX)

Tour guests will arrive at Dharamshala Airport as per their scheduled flight. Upon arrival, meet your Chauffeur at the airport and proceed to Dalhousie – a tiny tinsel town spread across five hills near the Dhauladhar mountain range. Known as Mini Switzerland filled with natural beauty and picturesque landscapes. On arrival in Dalhausie check in into hotel overnight stay in hotel.



MEAL: DINNER

DAY - 02 : DALHAUSIE - 🚔 - KHAJJIAR - 🚔 - CHAMBA - 🚔 - DALHAUSIE

Today we proceed to Khajjiar – also known as Mini Switzerland filled with natural beauty and picturesque landscapes.

Those who are adventurous can experience thrilling activities like Paragliding, Zorbing and Horse Ridding etc. at an additional cost. Later we visit Khajjiar Sanctuary famous for Deodar Forest, Grasslands and an easy going hiking trail which leads to untouched forest and a



mesmerising view of Pir Panjal ranges. In the evening, we stroll along the Ravi River and enjoy Boating at Chamera Dam. On evening come back to Dalhausie hotel overnight stay in hotel.

MEAL: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 03 : DALHAUSIE ~ = ~ DHARMSHALA (125 KM – 04 HRS DRIVE APPROX)

After a scrumptious breakfast, check-out from the hotel, and embark on a road journey to the quaint hill town of Mcleodganj. During this scenic drive, you can rejuvenate with your loved ones, and enjoy the mesmerizing views of the majestic mountains and lush green surroundings. Often called the Little Lhasa, Mcleodganj is home to the residence of his holiness, The Dalai Lama. The Tibetan Government in exile has been headquartered here for over three



decades. On your arrival in Mcleodganj, check-in at the hotel, and rest for some time.

MEAL - BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 04: LOCAL SIGHTSEEING OF DHARMSHALA

Today we explored Dharamshala. We took a photo stop at the Dharamshala Cricket Stadium. We then experience a ropeway ride known as Dharamshala Skyway offering stunning aerial views of the scenic town. Upon arrival we stroll around at the famous McLeod Ganj — a beautiful town nestled amidst majestic hills and lush greenery has a prominent Tibetan influence. Spend some time exploring McLeod Ganj. You can go shopping at the Tibetian Bazar. Later take a photo stop at Dalai Lama Monastery (subject to operation) — serene Temple complex known for its ornamental façade and vibrant prayer halls and we visit Saint John's Church — a Victorian era church built in the 18th century and Bhagsu Naag Temple — believed to be an ancient temple where Lord Shiva had prevailed himself.





Here we enjoy a small walk in the Himalayan Ranges, feel the freshness in the air while we walk through this picturesque paradise and witness the beautiful sunset in the Himalayas.

DAY 05 : DHARMSHALA ~ 🚝 ~ MANALI (220 KM - 06 HRS 30 MIN)

After breakfast, begin driving towards Manali. Treat your eyes to the snow-clad peaks and lush greenery, on the way. Upon arriving, check-in at your hotel. Relax for some time. You are free to spend the day as per your liking. In the evening, visit the vibrant and sprawling Mall road for shopping. You can get your hands on some nice woollen clothes, handicrafts and more. Dinner and overnight stay.



MEAL: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 06: MANALI ~ = ~ LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast is fixed for visiting the attractions of Old Manali, which is home to a number of famous temples. Today, you visit Manu Temple- close to the main market this temple is dedicated to Manu Rishi who was a popular Hindu Sage, Hadimba Devi Temple- an ancient temple that is dedicated to Hadmiba who was the wife of one of the five Pandavas Bhim and Vashisht Temple- believed to be around 4000 years old. The next visit is to the Tibetan Monastery. Later, meet the



exotic wildlife of the region at Van Vihar National Park. Back to the hotel for dinner. Stay overnight.

MEAL: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 07 : MANALI - 🚔 - SOLANG VALLEY – ATAL TUNNEL & KHOKSAR VILLAGE - 🚔 - JISPA



Early morning after breakfast, check out from the hotel & proceed for Solang Valley which is around 14 Kms North West of Manali town on the way to Rohtang Pass and is known for its summer and winter sport conditions. The sports most commonly offered are Parachuting, Paragliding, Skating and Zorbing. Next - Enjoy traversing the world's longest highway tunnel above 10,000ft from sea level. The tunnel is equipped with ultra-modern safety and other technical instruments. You will not lose your mobile network and high-speed 4G internet (BSNL only) even inside the tunnel. Cold and secluded yet startlingly wonderful, that's the perfect definition of Koksar, the first village that comes after entering Lahaul. A quaint village off the Manali— Leh highway on the banks of river Chandra lies Koksar, the gateway to lush green Lahaul valley. The close proximity to Rohtang pass of Peer Panjal range lends special character to this village. During summers, the whole area around Khoksar comes to life with carpets of colourful flowers all over the hills, luminous streams and a huge water fall nearby. The colourful Koksar Gompa adds to the charm of this village. This was the old trade route from Indian plains to West Asia and has Tibetan influence. After visiting all places proceed to Jispa. Reach Jispa by early evening. Avoid strenuous activity but go for a short acclimatization walk. Stay overnight in a campsite & lodge besides the Bhaga River.

MEAL: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 08 : JISPA - = - LEH (330 KM - 09 HRS DRIVE)

After an early breakfast, proceed to Leh over Baralacha Pass (4890 m). Sarchu (4253 mts), Namkeela, LachanglaPass (5065 mts) & Skyangchu Thang (Biggest & Highest plateau in the world of around 42 km) and Pang. Admire the beautiful scenic journey on the Manali Leh Highway (Considered to be the most beautiful views in the world). Cross the Taglangla Pass and travel through the scenic Indus Valley. Reach Leh in the evening. Overnight stay in Leh.



MEAL: BREAKFAST & DINNER

<u>DAY 09 : SIGHTSEEING - LEH - HALL OF FAME - MAGNETIC HILL - SANGAM (CONFLUENCE OF INDUS AND ZANSKAR RIVERS) - GURDWARA PATHAR SAHIB - LEH</u>

After a glorious morning flight over the Himalayas, reach Kushok Bakula Rimpochee airport and transfer to your hotel in Leh. If you want, you can relax a few hours at your hotel. Then, the driver picks you up from your hotel for a sightseeing tour around Leh. The first stop is at the Hall of Fame museum where you can learn more about

















the role of the Indian army in the region and Ladakh's history. After driving 30 km on the Leh-Srinagar highway, you arrive at the mysterious Magnetic Hill. When your driver turns the engine off with the gear in neutral, the car will start moving uphill as if attracted by a strange magnetic force that defies gravity. Something that you must see with your own eyes! The next stop is one of the most popular photo spots of Ladakh, the spectacular viewpoint over Sangam, the confluence of the Indus river (green colour) and the Zanskar river (blue or brown colour depending on the season). On the way back to Leh, visit the holy Sikh place Gurdwara Pathar Sahib and Spituk monastery. In the evening, your driver will drop you at Leh Main Bazar where you can do shopping. Overnight stay in Leh.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 10: LEH - KHARDUNG LA - DISKIT - HUNDER (NUBRA VALLEY)





After breakfast, your driver takes you to the Nubra valley passing through the Khardung La pass, the world's highest motorable road at an elevation of 5,602 metres. From the top, there is an amazing view of the K2 mountain range (the Karakoram). Drive down to the Nubra Valley which means "valley of flowers" in Ladakhi language. The valley lies at an average altitude of 3,100 metres and it is crisscrossed by the Nubra and Shayok rivers. Visit the Diskit monastery, the largest and oldest gompa in the Nubra valley. Perched atop a rocky hillock, the monastery was established by Changzem Tserab Zangpo in the 15th century. At the top of a nearby hill, there is a colossal 32-metre-high statue of Maitreya Buddha, one of the landmarks of the valley. From Diskit, follow the Shayok river for 10 km to reach Hunder village where you can spend the night.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

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DAY 11: LEH - HUNDER - SUMUR - SHAYOK - TANGTSE - PANGONG LAKE

This morning, experience a camel ride across the Hunder sand dunes.



The double-humped Bactrian camels were brought to Ladakh when Hunder was a stopping point for caravans travelling on the old Silk Road. Next, visit the Samstanling monastery in the charming village of Sumur. From here, drive along the Shayok river towards Pangong, an adventurous road trip through beautiful mountain scenery. After passing through Tangtse village, there is another 35 km to reach Pangong lake commonly known as Pangong Tso ("Tso" means "lake" in Ladakhi language). The lake lies at an elevation of 4,250m, it is 140 km in length but only 30% of it is in India. Despite its brackish water, the lake freezes completely in winter when temperatures fall well below -20°C. Pangong lake was made famous when it featured in the Bollywood movie "3 Idiots" released in 2009. Overnight stay in Pangong Lake.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 12: PANGONG LAKE - CHANG LA PASS - LEH











Take a stroll along the shore of Pangong lake and watch the sunrise over the glistening blue waters. The lake is a wonderful place for wildlife enthusiasts as it serves as a breeding site for various migratory birds. Next, go back towards Leh. After driving over the Chang La pass located at an altitude of 5,360m, you reach Chemrey village where you can visit the beautiful Chemrey monastery rising above the barley fields. The monastery was built in the 17th century in memory of the king Sengge Namgyal. In the Indus valley, head to Leh. On arrival you can visit local market for shopping after that come back to hotel overnight stay in Leh.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 13 : DEPARTURE FROM LEH CATCH FLIGHT FOR BACK TO HOME

Morning after breakfast it's time now to say goodbye. Let's stay in touch with us through email, phone, WhatsApp, Facebook, Instagram and meet again on yet another memorable tour. See you all!! Tour Guests will

proceed to Leh airport as per their scheduled flight 3 and start their return journey back home.

- > Khardungla pass is at a height of 18530ft, advised to relax and not exert due to lower oxygen levels.
- Please cooperate with the localities, hotels and driver as they of more helpful.
- > The above –mentioned itinerary is subject to change depending on the local weather, road, political scenario and health conditions.
- Room heaters are LPG heater (October to May), so it is advised not to be used on first day of the Tour, as the body needs to acclimatize to Lower oxygen Level.
- > Please note the hotels in Ladakh are basic in nature, the hotels offered to you are some of the best in that region.
- In order to visit Pangong Lake permission is required, hence requested to carry photo identification card as proof of identity.
- > While visit to Monastery, women are requested to cover their body and men in their full pants.
- > Pangong Lake is the highest salted water Lake in the world, shared by two countries India (25%) and China (75%)
- Enjoy the beauty of lake, while appreciating the changing color of fascinating high altitude lake.
- > We request you to follow and respect the rules in the temple and local sentiments.
- Avoid leather items and digital cameras in the Temple.
- Transits between two destinations depend upon weather and road conditions.
- > Any services unutilized are non refundable.
- India is a shopper dream. Shopping is recommended from the Government Emporium and suggested shop by us. Most of large stores will ship your purchases for you, though for convenience and to avoid postal delay, it is advisable to carry your shopping with you or to book it as baggage.
- Medicines of all kinds are usually available in local pharmacies with no prescription necessary. Check expiration dates.

- Avoid Acute Mountain Sickness
- Acute mountain sickness can occur to anyone at an altitude above 10,000 feets from the sea level. The most common symptoms of the acute mountain sickness are headache disturbed sleep, loss of appetite nausea, coughing, irregular breathing, breathlessness, lassitude and lack of concentration, Since Leh Town is situated at

an attitude of 11,500ft.above sea level, it is advisable to take the following precaution, so as to acclimatize your body properly.

- On arrival please rest for 24hrs, as you traveling to high Altitude from Low, due to low oxygen.
- Have plenty of drinking water or any kind of liquid (except alcohol)
- Incase you develop any of the above –mentioned symptoms, please consult Doctor.

Distance / Travelling time

- Please note that the distance and time taken and mentioned in the itinerary are to give you an approximate idea,
 and the same may vary according to road or weather condition and political scenario
- Meals at Hotel
- The meals provided at Hotel depends totally on the occupancy level at the hotel at that point, during high
 occupancy the hotel usually arrange for a buffet and if the occupancy is low the meals will be on alacarte.
