TOUR - ITINERARY

DAY 01: SRINAGAR AIRPORT ARRIVAL - = - LOCAL SIGHTSEEING OF SRINAGAR

After arrival proceed to Srinagar. On arrival at hotel check in after some rest today we will do some half a day of local sightseeing that includes a visit to the famous Mughal gardens of Nishat and Shalimar.

Built in between a period of 14 years the two gardens are a heritage left behind by the erstwhile Mughals, whose taste for laying exquisite gardens was fascinating.

With a backdrop of the sprawling Zabarwan mountains,

the gardens boast of green turfs, blooming flowers and cascading water fountains. Enjoy the famous Shikara ride (Own Cost) which is part of kashmir trip - Shikara-ride A dreamland for everyone that has actually been lusting for some relaxing moments in the



middle of the spectacular views of nature, Kashmir unquestionably triumphs. And Srinagar is the ideal place to start your journey. Overnight stay in Hotel Srinagar.

MEAL - BREAKFATS & DINNER

DAY 02 : SRINAGAR - = - DAY TRIP GULMARG - (60 KM) 2 HOURS ONEWAY

After breakfast in the morning, we will begin our country tour towards Gulmarg. We arrive at a small picturesue market town of Tangmarg and drive ahead on a scenic drive of 14 kilomete rs to Gulmarg. Later we will begin a short tour around the meadow familiarising ourselves with the beauty. In Gulmarg we will board the Gondola cable (Guest own cost) car system, and ascend towards the Afarwatt Mountain range. The 08 minutes of ropeway will take you past colorful shepherd hutments to the lower ridge of the Afarwatt peak. From here you can click lots of photos of the nearby mountain ranges that stand tall like sentinels guarding the rich natural beauty of Kashmir valley. We descend back to Gulmarg base after an hour or so and later do some horse-riding to the strawberry valley. After visiting Gulmarg come back to Srinagar overnight stay in Srinagar.



MEAL - BREAKFATS & DINNER

DAY 03: SRINAGAR - - SONMARG - (80 KM) 2 HOURS 30 MIN ONEWAY

We begin our day with a sumptous breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast we will drive to the majestic mountain resort of Sonamarg. The route towards Sonamarg takes us on a picturesque country side drive where we will come across rolling hills, green forests, clear water streams and blooming rice fields. On arrival in Sonmarg check in into hotel. In Sonmarg you will go sightseeing of Sonmarg i;e Vishansar Lake, Nilagrad River, White River Rafting at Shutkari Bridge at your own cost. In Sonamarg we will take a 3 hour walk or horseback trip (Guest own cost) to the Thajwass glacier. After our return we will visit the small town market for some snacks or just pay a visit observing the local people going with thier daily routine. We will drive back to Hotel in Sonmarg overnight.



MEAL - BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 05 : SONMARG KARGIL

DISTANCE: 80 KM - 04 Hrs DRIVE APPROX

After breakfast, you transferred from Sonmarg to Kargil. The most difficult section of this highway i.e. Zoji La (Zojila Pass) was a few hours away and you were eagerly waiting for an encounter with it. Conquering Zoji La (Zoji Pass or Zojila Pass) — "La" means pass. After crossing Zoji La the roads were very decent and at places went through snow walls on both sides. You had only covered 3 KMs after Zoji La where we saw a beautiful glacier and fresh water stream coming out of it that compelled you to take a halt. Drive towards Dras The Dras valley starts from the base of the Zojila pass, the Himalayan gateway to Ladakh. On the way you will explore Kargil War Memorial built alongside the highway in remembrance of sacrifices done by our armed forces during 1999 Kargil war. The memorial



is built on the foothills of Tololong Hill and has a huge epitaph with names of all the officers and soldiers who gave supreme sacrifice in the war. On arrival in karil overnight stay in Kargil.

MEAL - BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 05 : KARGIL 🚖 LAMAYURU

DISTANCE: 80 KM - 04 Hrs DRIVE APPROX

Morning after breakfast head west to Lamayuru, passing Ulley Tokpo en route. Located 103 km from Kargil, Lamayuru is a lovely village with a wonderful medieval gompa overlooking around 100 mudbrick homes. The village is surrounded by a surreal lunar landscape known as "moonland". In Lamayuru, you can should spend the night in a homestay, a great opportunity to stay with a local family and discover the Ladakhi customs and traditions. Your driver will help you to find a host family.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 6: LAMAYURU - RIZONG - LIKIR - GURDWARA PATHAR SAHIB - SPITUK - LEH

If you wake up early, you can join the monks for the morning prayer in the Dukhang (assembly hall). The Lamayuru monastery (also known as Yungdrung gompa) was established in the 11th century by Rinchen Zangpo. In the main prayer hall, there is a small cave where the Indian scholar Naropa meditated for several years.











From Lamayuru, head back east and stop at the isolated Rizong monastery. Located in an impressive rocky amphitheatre, the gompa is home to 40 monks and known for its strict rules and standards. Nearby, the Chulichan Nunnery school is surrounded by picturesque apricot orchards. Led by the younger brother of the Dalai Lama, the Likir monastery is one of the largest Gelugpa gompas in Ladakh. It is famous for its 22m-high statue of the Maitreya Buddha located just next to the main building. On the way back to Leh, visit Gurdwara Pathar Sahib, a small shrine devoted to Guru Nanak Dev Ji, the founder of Sikhism and stop at Spituk monastery that has a rich collection of thangkas (scroll painting on cotton) depicting the 21 forms of Tara, the protector of Tibet. You could also ask your driver to stop at the Hall of Fame, a museum commemorating the Indian Army and its role in the region.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 7: LEH (MAIN BAZAR, LEH PALACE, NAMGYAL TSEMO GOMPA, SHANTI STUPA)

Leh is at an elevation of 3,500 metres above sea level so you need to drink water and avoid any strenuous activity on the first day while your body acclimates to the change of atmospheric pressure due to the high altitude. Try typical Ladakhi food at a local restaurant.











Breakfast at hotel. In the afternoon, take a stroll through the twisting pathways of the picturesque old town. Its streets echo the stories of the past. The guided walking tour arranged by LAMO (Ladakh Arts and Media Organisation) is a great way to discover this historic site. Northeast of the old town is the Leh Palace, a large mud-brick complex with 9 storeys. It was constructed by the king of Ladakh in the early 17th century. It is worth climbing to the palace's roof for a good view of the city and its surroundings. Then, head to Namgyal Tsemo gompa which was built in 1430. The monastery is spectacularly located atop a rocky crag and it is visible from anywhere in Leh. The next destination is the Shanti Stupa, a famous Japanese peace pagoda that was inaugurated by the Dalai Lama in 1991. It is located on a hilltop high above Leh and it offers stunning vistas of Leh city and the surrounding mountains, making it a famous viewpoint for sunset. In the evening, go back to the Main Bazar where you can experience the hustle and bustle of the Ladakhi market or just sit on a bench and do people watching. In the same area, you can visit the Jama Masjid, the largest mosque in Ladakh. Near the State Bank of India building, the Gompa Soma is a quiet temple in the heart of Leh, the headquarters of the Ladakh Buddhist Association are also located within the complex.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 08: LEH - KHARDUNG LA - DISKIT - HUNDER (NUBRA VALLEY)





After breakfast, your driver takes you to the Nubra valley passing through the Khardung La pass, the world's highest motorable road at an elevation of 5,602 metres. From the top, there is an amazing view of the K2 mountain range (the Karakoram). Drive down to the Nubra Valley which means "valley of flowers" in Ladakhi language. The valley lies at an average altitude of 3,100 metres and it is crisscrossed by the Nubra and Shayok rivers. Visit the Diskit monastery, the largest and oldest gompa in the Nubra valley. Perched atop a rocky hillock, the monastery was established by Changzem Tserab Zangpo in the 15th century. At the top of a nearby hill, there is a colossal 32-metre-high statue of Maitreya Buddha, one of the landmarks of the valley. From Diskit, follow the Shayok river for 10 km to reach Hunder village where you can spend the night.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 09: LEH - HUNDER - SUMUR - SHAYOK - TANGTSE - PANGONG LAKE

This morning, experience a camel ride across the Hunder sand dunes.



The double-humped Bactrian camels were brought to Ladakh when Hunder was a stopping point for caravans travelling on the old Silk Road. Next, visit the Samstanling monastery in the charming village of Sumur. From here, drive along the Shayok river towards Pangong, an adventurous road trip through beautiful mountain scenery. After passing through Tangtse village, there is another 35 km to reach Pangong lake commonly known as Pangong Tso ("Tso" means "lake" in Ladakhi language). The lake lies at an elevation of 4,250m, it is 140 km in length but only 30% of it is in India. Despite its brackish water, the lake freezes completely in winter when temperatures fall well below -20°C. Pangong lake was made famous when it featured in the Bollywood movie "3 Idiots" released in 2009. Overnight stay in Pangong Lake.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 10: PANGONG LAKE - CHANG LA PASS - LEH











Take a stroll along the shore of Pangong lake and watch the sunrise over the glistening blue waters. The lake is a wonderful place for wildlife enthusiasts as it serves as a breeding site for various migratory birds. Next, go back towards Leh. After driving over the Chang La pass located at an altitude of 5,360m, you reach Chemrey village where you can visit the beautiful Chemrey monastery rising above the barley fields. The monastery was built in the 17th century in memory of the king Sengge Namgyal, In the Indus valley, head to Leh. On arrival you can visit local market for shopping after that come back to hotel overnight stay in Leh.

DAY 11: HOTEL - = - LEH AIRPORT CATCH FLIGHT FOR BACK TO HOME
