

TOUR ~ ITINERARY



DISTANCE - 23 KM - 01 Hrs DRIVE APPROX

After arrival in Srinagar transfer to Hotel and your kashmir tour package will start. Get fresh at hotel. Today we will do some half a day of local sightseeing that includes a visit to the famous Mughal gardens of Nishat and Shalimar. Built in between a period of 14 years the two gardens are a heritage left behind by the erstwhile Mughals, whose taste for laying exquisite gardens was fascinating.

With a backdrop of the sprawling Zabarwan mountains, the gardens boast of green turfs, blooming flowers and cascading water fountains. Enjoy the famous Shikara ride (Own Cost) which is part of kashmir trip - Shikara-ride A dreamland for everyone that has actually been lusting for some relaxing moments in the middle of the spectacular views of nature, Kashmir unquestionably triumphs. And Srinagar is the ideal place to start your journey. Overnight stay in Hotel Srinagar.




MEAL - DINNER

DAY 02 : SRINAGAR - 🚝 - DAY TRIP GULMARG

After breakfast in the morning, we will begin our country tour towards Gulmarg. We arrive at a small picturesue market town of Tangmarg and drive ahead on a scenic drive of 14 kilometers to Gulmarg.

Later we will begin a short tour around the meadow familarising ourselves with the beauty. In Gulmarg we will board the Gondola cable (Guest own cost) car system, and ascend towards the Afarwatt Mountain range. The 08 minutes of ropeway will take you past colorful shepherd hutments to the lower ridge of the Afarwatt peak. From here you can click lots of photos of the nearby mountain ranges that stand tall like



sentinels guarding the rich natural beauty of Kashmir valley. We descend back to Gulmarg base after an hour or so and later do some horse-riding to the strawberry valley. After visiting Gulmarg overnight stay in Srinagar.

MEAL - BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 03 : SRINAGAR - 🚝 - DAY TRIP PAHALGAM

DISTANCE - 170 KM - 04 Hrs 50 Min DRIVE APPROX

We will begin our trip towards Pahalgam. This road connects the Valley to the rest of the country. We drive past the saffron fields of Pampore, the marvellous ruins of Avantipura and the village of Bijbehara which remains famous as the bread basket of Kashmir. You can even sample a few exotic breads sold by vendors near the road. We switch the the national highway at Khanabal and drive through the second largest city of



Anantnag. From here the road turns scenic as we drive parallel on the Lidder river flowing from the opposite direction. After the visit of Pahalgam Valley come back to Srinagar overnight stay in Srinagar.

MEAL - BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 04 : SRINAGAR AIRPORT DROPPING 🛛 🔨 CATCH FLIGHT FOR LEH

In the morning, you'll be escorted to Srinagar Airport to catch flight for onward destination Cochin. It's time to say goodbye to the vistas of Kashmir.

MEAL - BREAKFAST

ARRIVAL IN LEH AIRPORT - 🚝 - A DESERT LAND IN THE HIMALAYAS



With one of the best flight journeys of your life, you will reach the Kushok Bakula Rimpochee Airport in Leh. If you are lucky enough to fly on a clear day, the surreal vistas of some mighty mountains like K2, Gasherbrum and Nanga Parbat from the aeroplane will surely be a delight to your eyes. Leh Airport to Hotel distance will be around 10 to 15 KM.

As you will land at the airport, you'll be welcomed by our representative who will take you to your hotel for check-in through a luxury drive. At the hotel, Rest of the day is free for relaxation and acclimatisation as this is necessary for getting acclimatised at the high altitude. In the evening, one can visit the colourful market of Leh. An overnight stay in the hotel Leh.

MEALS: DINNER

DAY 05 : SIGHTSEEING - LEH - HALL OF FAME - MAGNETIC HILL - SANGAM (CONFLUENCE OF INDUS AND ZANSKAR RIVERS) - GURDWARA PATHAR SAHIB - LEH

After a glorious morning flight over the Himalayas, reach Kushok Bakula Rimpochee airport and transfer to your hotel in Leh.



If you want, you can relax a few hours at your hotel. Then, the driver picks you up from your hotel for a sightseeing tour around Leh. The first stop is at the Hall of Fame museum where you can learn more about the role of the Indian army in the region and Ladakh's history. After driving 30 km on the Leh-Srinagar highway, you arrive at the mysterious Magnetic Hill. When your driver turns the engine off with the gear in neutral, the car will start moving uphill as if attracted by a strange magnetic force that defies gravity. Something that you must see with your own eyes! The next stop is one of the Indus river (green colour) and the Zanskar river (blue or brown colour depending on the season). On the way back to Leh, visit the holy Sikh place Gurdwara Pathar Sahib and Spituk monastery. In the evening, your driver will drop you at Leh Main Bazar where you can do shopping. Overnight stay in Leh.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 06 : LEH - KHARDUNG LA - DISKIT - HUNDER (NUBRA VALLEY)



After breakfast, your driver takes you to the Nubra valley passing through the Khardung La pass, the world's highest motorable road at an elevation of 5,602 metres. From the top, there is an amazing view of the K2 mountain range (the Karakoram). Drive down to the Nubra Valley which means "valley of flowers" in Ladakhi language. The valley lies at an average altitude of 3,100 metres and it is crisscrossed by the Nubra and Shayok rivers. Visit the Diskit monastery, the largest and oldest gompa in the Nubra valley. Perched atop a rocky hillock, the monastery was established by Changzem Tserab Zangpo in the 15th century. At the top of a nearby hill, there is a colossal 32-metre-high statue of Maitreya Buddha, one of the landmarks of the valley. From Diskit, follow the Shayok river for 10 km to reach Hunder village where you can spend the night.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 07 : LEH - HUNDER - SUMUR - SHAYOK - TANGTSE - PANGONG LAKE



This morning, experience a camel ride across the Hunder sand dunes. The double-humped Bactrian camels were brought to Ladakh when Hunder was a stopping point for caravans travelling on the old Silk Road. Next, visit the Samstanling monastery in the charming village of Sumur. From here, drive along the Shayok river towards Pangong, an adventurous road trip through beautiful mountain scenery. After passing through Tangtse village, there is another 35 km to reach Pangong lake commonly known as Pangong Tso ("Tso" means "lake" in Ladakhi language). The lake lies at an elevation of 4,250m, it is 140 km in length but only 30% of it is in India. Despite its brackish water, the lake freezes completely in winter when temperatures fall well below -20°C. Pangong lake was made famous when it featured in the Bollywood movie "3 Idiots" released in 2009. Overnight stay in Pangong Lake.

MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER

DAY 08 : PANGONG LAKE - CHANG LA PASS - LEH



Take a stroll along the shore of Pangong lake and watch the sunrise over the glistening blue waters. The lake is a wonderful place for wildlife enthusiasts as it serves as a breeding site for various migratory birds. Next, go back towards Leh. After driving over the Chang La pass located at an altitude of 5,360m, you reach Chemrey village where you can visit the beautiful Chemrey monastery rising above the barley fields. The monastery was built in the 17th century in memory of the king Sengge Namgyal. In the Indus valley, head to Leh. On arrival you can visit local market for shopping after that come back to hotel overnight stay in Leh.

DAY 09 : HOTEL TO LEH AIRPORT DROP ~ 🗮 ~ CATCH FLIGHT FOR HOME

- Please note that breakfast is not available on the day of check in. the number of breakfast will be same as the number of nights' accommodation.

- This is proposed service costing. We are not holding any confirmed vehicle & hotel reservations for your travel. The same is subject to availability at the time of booking. It's possible at the time of confirmation the prices may vary.
- > All places sightseeing and orientations are subject to given by car driver.
- > Any activity/sightseeing cannot done twice
- > Any changes / deviations must be given in writing 10 days prior to the tour and will be subject to availability.
- > In All Hotels Base category rooms are allocated for the stay, In case of up gradation it will be charged.
- In case of non-availability of rooms at the hotel mentioned, we shall provide alternative hotels of similar category
- Ladakh being a cold desert doesn't have star category hotels. Hotels in Leh are very basic which cannot be compared with the hotels of other developed destinations
- Most of the hotels in the region do not have elevators and guests would have to use stairs to reach their rooms
- > Check in Check out 12.00 noon at all hotels.
- > Fixed menu/buffet meals will be provided at the hotels
- > Only vegetarian meals will be provided at Nubra and Pangong
- > Hotels may not be able to give you the same rooms on your 2nd and 3rd visit
- > Hotels/camps provide hot water from 6-8 AM and 6-8 PM only
- > One room can accommodate a maximum of 3 passengers (1 Dbl Room + 1 extra bed)
- Per person rates (Rs) are usually applicable on 2 persons staying together sharing the same room, unless specified otherwise
- > The hotels and services as mentioned in the itinerary are subject to confirmation.
- > Leh and remote areas have regular power outages
- Since vehicles in Leh are purely owned and managed by the Transport Union, your vehicle and drivers may change for every transfer and sightseeing

- > Vehicle provided will be as per the itinerary and not at personal disposal
- > If a vehicle is used for shopping, visiting markets and restaurants, there will be extra charges
- Pre-paid sim cards are not usable in Ladakh. Only postpaid connection will be active that too BSNL, Airtel and Aircel. Vodafone and Idea may or may not work

- > During the period of May to August, there is lot of rush/traffic jams in the sector. Please be patient at the time of check-in/sightseeing
