


# TOUR ~ ITINERARY

# DAY 01 : 🧮 ARRIVAL SRINAGAR AIRPORT - 🚝 - PAHALGAM (80 KM) 4 HOURS JOURNEY

Arrival at Srinagar, the capital city of Kashmir.

Pick up from Airport and transfers to Pahalgam. Considered as a Jewel in the Liddar Valley, Pahalgam is also lovingly called "Valley of Shepherds". It is famous for its natural beauty, beautiful view of the green meadows, wooded forest, trout fishing, camping pony trekking and is also the starting point for Amarnath Yatra. Evening check in to hotel and after dinner overnight stay at Pahalgam hotel.

## DAY 02 : PAHALGAM - 🚝 - LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, enjoy panoramic views of Pahalgam town and Lidder Valley. Start with Aru Valley which is a small village, 15 km upstream the Lidder River,

The route is picturesque with ample campsites. This village is the starting point for treks to the Kolahoi glacier. Later, visit Chandanwari, 16 Km which is the starting point of sacred Amarnath Yatra. Chandanwari is famous for snow sledging on a snow bridge, enroute you can visit Hajan, an idyllic picnic spot and Betaab valley. Dinner & overnight in the hotel.

#### DAY 03 : PAHALGAM - 🚝 - SRINAGAR & LOCAL SIGHTSEEING OF SRINAGAR

After breakfast proceed to Srinagar. Today we will do some half a day of local sightseeing that includes a visit to the famous Mughal gardens of Nishat and Shalimar.

Built in between a period of 14 years the two gardens are a heritage left behind by the erstwhile Mughals, whose taste for laying exquisite gardens was fascinating.

With a backdrop of the sprawling Zabarwan mountains,

the gardens boast of green turfs, blooming flowers and cascading water fountains. Enjoy the famous Shikara ride (Own Cost) which is part of kashmir trip - Shikara-ride A dreamland for everyone



that has actually been lusting for some relaxing moments in the middle of the spectacular views of nature, Kashmir unquestionably triumphs. And Srinagar is the ideal place to start your journey. Overnight stay in Hotel Srinagar.

#### MEAL - BREAKFATS & DINNER

DAY 04 : SRINAGAR - 🚝 - DAY TRIP GULMARG

After breakfast in the morning,

we will begin our country tour towards Gulmarg. We arrive at a small picturesue market town of Tangmarg and drive ahead on a scenic drive of 14 kilometers to Gulmarg. Later we will begin a short tour around the meadow familarising ourselves with the beauty. In Gulmarg we will board the Gondola cable (Guest own cost) car system, and ascend



towards the Afarwatt Mountain range. The 08 minutes of ropeway will take you past colorful shepherd hutments to the lower ridge of the Afarwatt peak. From here you can click lots of photos of the nearby mountain ranges that stand tall like sentinels guarding the rich natural beauty of Kashmir valley. We descend back to Gulmarg base after an hour or so and later do some horse-riding to the strawberry valley. After visiting Gulmarg come back to Srinagar overnight stay in Srinagar.

#### **MEAL - BREAKFATS & DINNER**

#### DAY 05 : SRINAGAR - 💳 - SONMARG

We begin our day with a sumptous breakfast at the hotel.

After breakfast we will drive to the majestic mountain resort of Sonamarg. The route towards Sonamarg takes us on a picturesque country side drive where we will come across rolling hills, green forests, clear water streams and blooming rice fields. In Sonmarg you will go sightseeing of Sonmarg i;e Vishansar Lake, Nilagrad River, White River Rafting at Shutkari Bridge at your own cost. In Sonamarg we will take a 3 hour walk or horseback trip (Guest own cost) to the Thajwass glacier. After our return we will visit the small town market for some snacks or just pay a visit



observing the local people going with thier daily routine. On evening check in into hotel overnight stay in hotel at Sonmarg.

Note - Srinagar Taxi is not authorized to do the local sightseeing of Sonmarg. So guests have to book a local taxi union car for Sonmarg local sightseeing.

**MEAL - BREAKFAST & DINNER** 

### DAY 06 : SONMARG - 🚝 - KARGIL

Begins with a delicious breakfast in the hotel at Sonmarg. Check-out and proceed to Kargil.

You will have to start early from Sonamarg and by early, possibly by 6 or 7 am. Then the same amount of time to travel back. So 8-9 hours will be spent on the road and then you will have to keep at least 2-3 hours for sightseeing and breaks in between.

On the way, you will also cross Zojila Pass, Zero Point, and Zojila War Memorial and can take breaks there. The condition of the road between Sonmarg and Kargil is good for the most part of it. Right after Sonamarg, you will start climbing up the notorious Zojila Pass. For about 10 kilometers, the road will remain good and will then start to deteriorate as you approach the top of the pass. On arrival at Kargil spend some time at the war memorial. There is also an informative video that they plan for the tourists that you can see. There are a couple of dhabas near the war memorial where you can also have your lunch before starting on the way back. On evening check in into hotel overnight stay in hotel at Kargil.

# DAY 07 : KARGIL - 🚝 - LEH (220 KM - APPROX 05 HRS DRIVE)

Post breakfast embark on a drive to Leh which is 230 kilometers from Kargil town. En-route visit Mulbek, Giant Living Buddha Sculpture on Rock Mountain, Lamayuru, one of the oldest Monastery of Ladakh and enjoy the view of Moon Landscape, Magnetic hills, Sangum where Indus & Zanskar river meets, Pathar Sahab Gurudwara. By the evening, arrive Leh and check in at the hotel in Leh.

# DAY 08 : LEH - KHARDUNG LA - 🚝 - DISKIT - 🚝 - HUNDER (NUBRA VALLEY)



After breakfast, your driver takes you to the Nubra valley passing through the Khardung La pass, the world's highest motorable road at an elevation of 5,602 metres. From the top, there is an amazing view of the K2 mountain range (the Karakoram). Drive down to the Nubra Valley which means "valley of flowers" in Ladakhi language. The valley lies at an average altitude of 3,100 metres and it is crisscrossed by the Nubra and Shayok rivers. Visit the Diskit monastery, the largest and oldest gompa in the Nubra valley. Perched atop a rocky hillock, the monastery was established by Changzem Tserab Zangpo in the 15th century. At the top of a nearby hill, there is a colossal 32-metre-high statue of Maitreya Buddha, one of the landmarks of the valley. From Diskit, follow the Shayok river for 10 km to reach Hunder village where you can spend the night.

#### DAY 09 : HUNDER (NUBRA VALLEY) - 🚝 - SUMUR - SHAYOK - TANGTSE - PANGONG LAKE



This morning, experience a camel ride across the Hunder sand dunes. The double-humped Bactrian camels were brought to Ladakh when Hunder was a stopping point for caravans travelling on the old Silk Road. Next, visit the Samstanling monastery in the charming village of Sumur. From here, drive along the Shayok river towards Pangong, an adventurous road trip through beautiful mountain scenery. After passing through Tangtse village, there is another 35 km to reach Pangong lake commonly known as Pangong Tso ("Tso" means "lake" in Ladakhi language). The lake lies at an elevation of 4,250m, it is 140 km in length but only 30% of it is in India. Despite its brackish water, the lake freezes completely in winter when temperatures fall well below -20°C. Pangong lake was made famous when it featured in the Bollywood movie "3 Idiots" released in 2009. Overnight stay in Pangong Lake.

#### **MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER**

#### DAY 10 : PANGONG LAKE - 🚝 - CHANG LA PASS – LEH



Take a stroll along the shore of Pangong lake and watch the sunrise over the glistening blue waters. The lake is a wonderful place for wildlife enthusiasts as it serves as a breeding site for various migratory birds. Next, go back towards Leh. After driving over the Chang La pass located at an altitude of 5,360m, you reach Chemrey village where you can visit the beautiful Chemrey monastery rising above the barley fields. The monastery was built in the 17th century in memory of the king Sengge Namgyal. In the Indus valley, head to Leh. On arrival you can visit local market for shopping after that come back to hotel overnight stay in Leh.

# DAY 11 : LEH HOTEL - 🚝 - LEH AIRPORT - 🧮 CATCH FLIGHT FOR HOME

Morning after breakfast transfer to Leh Airport & catch flight for your next destination Amritsar.

Tour guests will arrive at Amritsar Airport as per their scheduled flight. Upon arrival, meet your Chauffeur at the airport and proceed to hotel.

On arrival check in into hotel after some rest. Visit - Golden Temple – also known as Harmandir Sahib or Darbar Sahib is the holiest Gurdwara and the most important pilgrimage site of Sikhism, here we also see Akal Takht – throne of immortal and highest seat of authority of Khalsa. Golden temple at night is certainly a treat for the eyes & soul. We then have free time for shopping. Overnight stay in Amritsar Hotel.

# DAY 12 : AMRITSAR ~ 🚎 ~ LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

Today we proceed to Amritsar local sightseeing. First we visited Jallianwala Bagh – a historic garden and memorial of national importance preserved

in the memory of those who were killed in the Jallianwala Massacre that happened on 13th April 1919 and the Partition Museum – world's first Museum dedicated to the Partition of



1947. On afternoon transfer to Attari Wagah Border (subject to operation) – to witness the prestigious lowering of the flags ceremony daily military practice that the security forces of India and Pakistan have jointly followed since 1959. Later in the evening we enjoy the Sound & Light Show at Gobindgarh Fort. We then have free time for shopping.

- Please note that breakfast is not available on the day of check in. the number of breakfast will be same as the number of nights' accommodation.
- This is purely an individual itinerary designed especially for given number of passengers; any increase or decrease in total number of passengers will lead to re-costing.
- This is proposed service costing. We are not holding any confirmed vehicle & hotel reservations for your travel. The same is subject to availability at the time of booking. It's possible at the time of confirmation the prices may vary.
- Sightseeing at destinations (Pahalgam, Gulmarg, Sonmarg,) are to be done by local village union taxi (Guest will pay directly), ponies, horses, sledges, chained-gear require for Tangmarg to Gulmarg in Heavy snow conditions, ATV rides etc. Local restrictions in place for outside vehicles. Example of destinations are Aru Valley, Betaab Valley, Chandanwari, Zero Point, Zojilla, Dras, Kargil, etc.
- For safety reasons, the traffic across the pass is regulated when the pass is declared open. In the first couple of months, only one-way traffic is allowed on alternate days. So please keep this in mind when you plan your trip and have to cross Zojila Pass.
- Sometimes, if there is not a lot of snow on the road, traffic can also be allowed from both sides on the same day. In that case, from the Kargil side, vehicles are allowed to travel between 4 am to 10 am. The traffic from the Sonamarg side is released after 10 am. The pass remains closed on Fridays for all kinds of traffic for maintenance work.

- > All places sightseeing and orientations are subject to given by car driver.
- Any activity/sightseeing cannot done twice
- Any changes / deviations must be given in writing 10 days prior to the tour and will be subject to availability.
- In All Hotels Base category rooms are allocated for the stay, In case of up gradation it will be charged.
- In case of non-availability of rooms at the hotel mentioned, we shall provide alternative hotels of similar category
- Most of the hotels in the region do not have elevators and guests would have to use stairs to reach their rooms
