

### **TOUR ~ ITINERARY**

# DAY 01: CATCH FLIGHT FOR LEHARRIVAL IN LEH AIRPORT - A DESERT LAND IN THE HIMALAYAS

With one of the best flight journeys of your life, you will reach the Kushok Bakula Rimpochee Airport in Leh. If you are lucky enough to fly on a clear day, the surreal vistas of some mighty mountains like K2, Gasherbrum and Nanga Parbat from the aeroplane will surely be a delight to your eyes. Leh Airport to Hotel distance will be around 10 to 15 KM.

As you will land at the airport, you'll be welcomed by our representative who will take you to your hotel for check-in through a luxury drive. At the hotel, Rest of the day is free for relaxation and



acclimatisation as this is necessary for getting acclimatised at the high altitude. In the evening, one can visit the colourful market of Leh. An overnight stay in the hotel Leh.

## DAY 02: SIGHTSEEING - LEH - HALL OF FAME - MAGNETIC HILL - SANGAM (CONFLUENCE OF INDUS AND ZANSKAR RIVERS) - GURDWARA PATHAR SAHIB - LEH

After a glorious morning flight over the Himalayas, reach Kushok Bakula Rimpochee airport and transfer to your hotel in Leh.

If you want, you can relax a few hours at your hotel. Then, the driver picks you up from your hotel for a sightseeing tour around Leh. The first stop is at the Hall of Fame museum where you can learn more about the role of the Indian army in the region and Ladakh's history. After driving 30 km on the Leh-Srinagar highway, you arrive at the mysterious Magnetic Hill. When your driver turns the engine off with

















the gear in neutral, the car will start moving uphill as if attracted by a strange magnetic force that defies gravity. Something that you must see with your own eyes! The next stop is one of the most popular photo spots of Ladakh, the spectacular viewpoint over Sangam, the confluence of the Indus river (green colour) and the Zanskar river (blue or brown colour depending on the season). On the way back to Leh, visit the holy Sikh place Gurdwara Pathar Sahib and Spituk monastery. In the evening, your driver will drop you at Leh Main Bazar where you can do shopping. Overnight stay in Leh.

**MEALS: BREAKFAST & DINNER** 

#### DAY 03: LEH - KHARDUNG LA - DISKIT - HUNDER (NUBRA VALLEY)





After breakfast, your driver takes you to the Nubra valley passing through the Khardung La pass, the world's highest motorable road at an elevation of 5,602 metres. From the top, there is an amazing view of the K2 mountain range (the Karakoram). Drive down to the Nubra Valley which means "valley of flowers" in Ladakhi language. The valley lies at an average altitude of 3,100 metres and it is crisscrossed by the Nubra and Shayok rivers. Visit the Diskit monastery, the largest and oldest gompa in the Nubra valley. Perched atop a rocky hillock, the monastery was established by Changzem Tserab Zangpo in the 15th century. At the top of a nearby hill, there is a colossal 32-metre-high statue of Maitreya Buddha, one of the landmarks of the valley. From Diskit, follow the Shayok river for 10 km to reach Hunder village where you can spend the night.

#### DAY 04: LEH - HUNDER - SUMUR - SHAYOK - TANGTSE - PANGONG LAKE


This morning, experience a camel ride across the Hunder sand dunes. The double-humped Bactrian camels were brought to Ladakh when Hunder was a stopping point for caravans travelling on the old Silk Road. Next, visit the Samstanling monastery in the charming village of Sumur. From here, drive along the Shayok river towards Pangong, an adventurous road trip through beautiful mountain scenery. After passing through Tangtse village, there is another 35 km to reach Pangong lake commonly known as



Pangong Tso ("Tso" means "lake" in Ladakhi language). The lake lies at an elevation of 4,250m, it is 140 km in length but only 30% of it is in India. Despite its brackish water, the lake freezes completely in winter when temperatures fall well below -20°C. Pangong lake was made famous when it featured in the Bollywood movie "3 Idiots" released in 2009. Overnight stay in Pangong Lake.

#### DAY 05: PANGONG LAKE - CHANG LA PASS - LEH











Take a stroll along the shore of Pangong lake and watch the sunrise over the glistening blue waters. The lake is a wonderful place for wildlife enthusiasts as it serves as a breeding site for various migratory birds. Next, go back towards Leh. After driving over the Chang La pass located at an altitude of 5,360m, you reach Chemrey village where you can visit the beautiful Chemrey monastery rising above the barley fields. The monastery was built in the 17th century in memory of the king Sengge Namgyal. In the Indus valley, head to Leh. On arrival you can visit local market for shopping after that come back to hotel overnight stay in Leh.

## ARRIVAL AMRITSAR AIRPORT ~ = ~ HOTEL

Tour guests will arrive at Amritsar Airport as per their scheduled flight. Upon arrival, meet your

Chauffeur at the airport and proceed to hotel.

On arrival check in into hotel after some rest. Visit - Golden Temple – also known as Harmandir Sahib or Darbar Sahib is the holiest Gurdwara and the most important pilgrimage site of Sikhism, here we also see Akal Takht – throne of immortal and highest seat of authority of Khalsa. Golden temple at night is certainly a treat for the eyes & soul. We then have free time for shopping. Overnight stay in Amritsar Hotel.

### DAY 07 : AMRITSAR ~ = ~ LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

Today we proceed to Amritsar local sightseeing. First we visited Jallianwala Bagh – a historic garden

and memorial of national importance preserved

in the memory of those who were killed in the Jallianwala Massacre that happened on 13th April 1919 and the Partition Museum – world's first Museum dedicated to the Partition of 1947. On afternoon transfer to Attari Wagah Border (subject to operation) – to witness the prestigious lowering of the flags ceremony daily military practice that the security forces of India and Pakistan have jointly



followed since 1959. Later in the evening we enjoy the Sound & Light Show at Gobindgarh Fort. We then have free time for shopping.

#### **MEAL - BREAKFAST & DINNER**

### DAY 08 : AMRITSAR ~ F ~ DALHOUSIE ~ DISTANCE - 210 KM - 05 Hrs DRIVE APPROX

Morning after breakfast get ready to enter in Himachal Pradesh. Proceed by road to Dalhouise. This spot lives at the western side of Dhauladhar

mountain ranges with a height of 2080m. In the focal point of a lush knoll mountain is 1.5 m long Khajjiar lake, called the Kund, structures the highlight of Khajjiar. It is 24 Km from Dalhousie while in transit to Chamba. Or then again, we can call it the "Gateway to Chamba." Dalhousie has shields to its culture, painstaking work, and design under a solitary dynasty. At night, we prescribe you to visit Mall road and taste various assortments of nourishments.

### DAY 09: DALHOUSIE ~ A DALHOUSIE TO KHAJJIAR AND BACK TO DALHOUSIE

Next destination is one you have been sitting tight for - the extremely popular Khajjiar. Verdant green pasture of this town anticipates your appearance, and you would express gratitude toward us for this grand visit. At the center of the foothills is the pleasant Khajjiar Lake, peaceful and quiet, where you can visit the following day in the wake of going through this day at relaxation.

### DAY 10: DALHOUSIE ~ F ~ DHARMSHALA - DISTANCE - 125 KM - 04 Hrs DRIVE APPROX

Today we proceed to Dharamshala -

A hillside city surrounded by cedar forests located on the edge of the Himalayas known as the home of the Dalai Lama. En route we visit Kangra Fort – the largest fort in the Himalayas built atop a hill with a sweeping view of the Kangra valley. We then visited Chinmaya Tapovan – an ashram at the foot of the Dhauladhar ranges in the Kangra Valley. Here we visit the meditation hall. A small walk to reach the Ashram through the dense pine forest offers a panoramic view. Upon arrival at Dharamshala



free time to relax and explore the surroundings. Overnight stay in Dharamshala
